In order to provide quality tournaments we need adult volunteers to work tables at all 2010 ISWA State events. The ISWA encourages clubs to recruit 8-10 volunteers to work a table at state events. This allows volunteers to rotate in and out during the course of the day and the table to run smoothly throughout the event. Your club can even set up camp near their assigned mat.

Individual volunteers are also very important and will be paired to work together with others.

Clubs must submit their table help sign-in sheet prior to the start of competition. Additional points will be awarded only after verification by Patt Van Horn, ISWA Tournament Director

The clubs wishing to earn team points must register with Patt Van Horn and assume responsibility for running a table, prior to the start of competition.
